

## **Queen Sirikit National Institute of Child Health's key responsibilities**

**By Royal Decree B.E. 2539 (1996) organizing Department of Medical Services, Ministry of Public Health, Queen Sirikit National Institute of Child Health is regulated to take responsibilities as follows:**

- ▶ To study, analyze, research and develop medical knowledge particularly in pediatric diseases,**
- ▶ To transfer knowledge and technology both in theory and practice to doctors, resident interns, medical students as well as public health personnel to have experts in their fields,**
- ▶ To perform as a referral center for all pediatric subspecialties, diagnosis, investigation, rehabilitation, prevention including consultation from hospitals nationwide,**
- ▶ To cooperate with other related sectors.**
